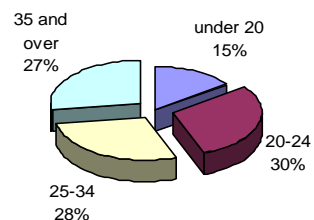

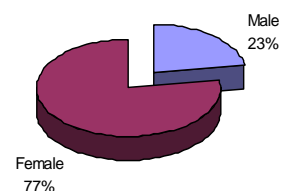
2004/05 EOPS Unduplicated Count by Age

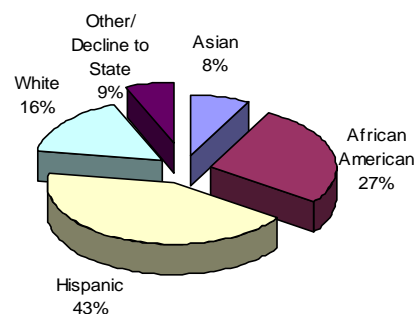

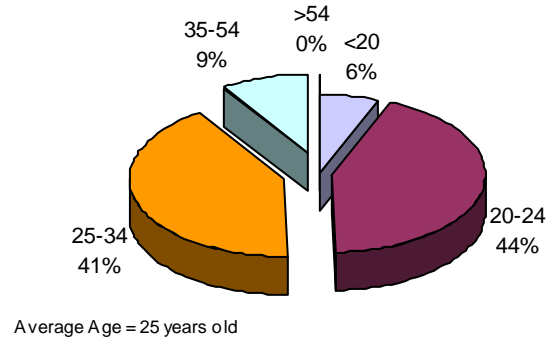

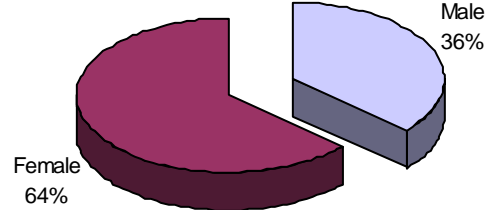
Fall 2005 Int'l Students Unduplicated Count by Age

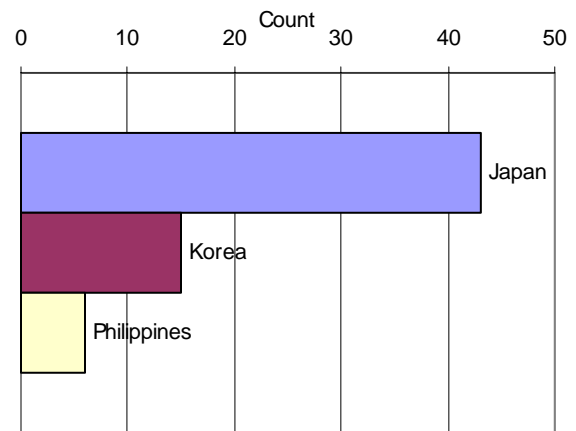
Fall 2005 Int'l Students Unduplicated Count by Gender
