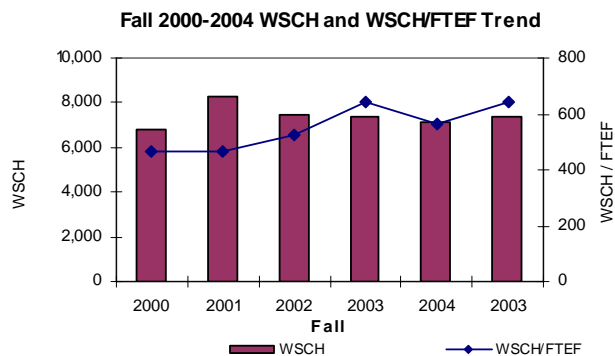

Fall 2000-2004 WSCH and WSCH/FTEF Trend



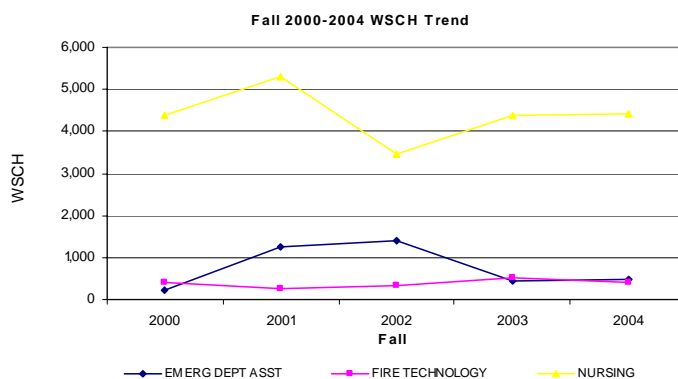

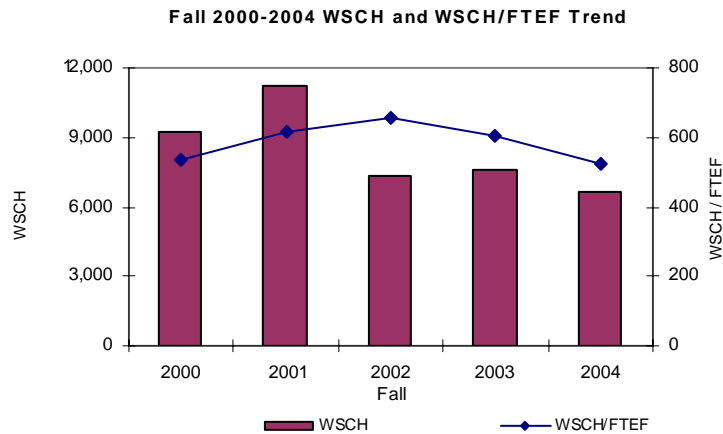
